#### **Educational Scholarship Application**

To promote attendance from out of state/province members, the Rocky Mountain Section of AACC is sponsoring up to **three Educational Scholarships** in an amount not to exceed \$500 each to attend the 2017 Rocky Mountain Section Spring meeting in **Sal Lake City, April 06-07, 2017**.

The criteria for the **Rocky Mountain Section Spring Meeting Education Awards** are as follows:
