



To Our Valued Deer Valley Resort Guests:

In accordance with recent CDC recommendations and Summit and Wasatch Counties designation as areas of high transmission, we are updating our COVID-19 guidelines, effective December 23, 2021. <https://www.deervalley.com/about-us/covid-operations>

Thank you for taking the necessary steps to keep your guests and Deer Valley associates safe during this unprecedented time.

Deer Valley Guidelines:

All visitors, guests, residents, and staff at Deer Valley Resort are expected to follow these rules:

- 1. While on Deer Valley property, masks or facial coverings are required to be worn while indoors by all guests and staff, regardless of vaccination status, except when eating or drinking while seated at a table. Single layer buffs and perforated or vented masks are not allowed.*
- 2. Outdoors, masks are not required, unless an unvaccinated individual cannot maintain physical distance from others (i.e., maintaining a minimum 6-feet of distance, and having less than 15 minutes of close contact in a 24-hour period).*
- 3. Deer Valley Resort strongly requests that you and your guests stay home if you are feeling ill or experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19 or any other contagious illness.*
- 4. By entering the resort and lodging properties, you are verifying that you have not shown symptoms of COVID-19 and are healthy.*
- 5. The private event host will communicate the Deer Valley COVID-19 guidelines to their guests prior to the event. The Deer Valley staff will require that all guests maintain safe practices, including wearing a mask indoors and keeping a safe distance when necessary.*
- 6. Failure to comply with Deer Valley's policies will jeopardize the success of the contracted event. Deer Valley Resort will do its best to inform guests to remain masked when indoors and not dining, however if a guest refuses to follow our policies we will request that they leave the premises immediately.*
- 7. Complimentary disposable masks will be made available for guests at all venues.*
